What is Festival of Neighbourhoods?

Initiated in 1994 by individuals committed to building healthy communities, Kitchener Festival of Neighbourhoods is an initiative that encourages individuals and families to build stronger relationships with their neighbours and to celebrate their community.

Festival of Neighbourhoods invites citizens to plan activities, projects, events or gatherings in their neighbourhoods that bring neighbours together face-to-face and are open to everyone within the neighbourhood, as defined by those planning the activities.

How to Participate in Festival of Neighbourhoods

Step 1

Decide what the geographical boundaries are of YOUR neighbourhood - which streets, homes, multi-unit complex, etc. It can be big or small. It's up to you.

Step 2

Plan an activity that would include EVERYONE in YOUR neighbourhood and brings them together face-to-face so they can get to know each other.
