Are you an older adult living in Waterloo Region? There are a variety of programs and resources available through different levels of government to provide income security for those who have retired or are in need financially for other reasons. Use this information page to find out which services you're eligible for to make sure you're not missing out.

Canada Pension Plan (CPP)

Under age 60?

 If working, the contributions you make to the CPP will impact the amount you receive upon retirement

Age 60-64?

You can choose to receive your
 CPP Retirement Pension early
 with a reduction

Age 65+?

 You are eligible to receive your full CPP Retirement Pension (if you delay until age 70, you will recieve it with an increase, known as a Post-Retirement Benefit)

Canada Old Age Security (OAS)

Age 65+?

- If your individual annual income is less than \$123,302: apply for an OAS pension
- If one of the following is true apply for the OAS Guaranteed Income Supplement (also automatically applies you for Ontario Guaranteed Annual Income System):
 - You are single/widowed/divorced and your annual income is less than \$18,096
 - Your spouse/common-law partner receives a full OAS pension and your combined annual income is less than \$23,094
 - Your spouse/common-law partner either receives no OAS pension at all or only receives the Allowance and your combined annual income is less than \$43,392

Age 60-64?

- If your spouse/common-law partner receives OAS, they're eligible for the Guarenteed Income Supplement, and you have a combined annual income of less than \$33,456: apply for the **OAS Allowance**
- If your spouse/common-law partner has passed away, you haven't remarried or entered into a common-law relationship and your annual income is less than \$23,350: apply for **OAS Allowance for the Survivor**

*Income = CPP Pension + Registered Retirement Saving Plans/Income Funds (RRSP/RRIF) + any other sources of income/investments

Under age 65?

- Ontario Trillium Drug
 Program

Age 65+ (or living in a longterm care/special care home)?

- Ontario Drug Benefit Program
 - apply online, visit your pharmacy, or call 1-888-405-0405

Energy?

- Ontario Electricity Support Program (OESP) - on-bill credits for lower income electricity customers
 - apply online, or through an agency such as the Social Development Centre (call 519-579-3800 to book an appointment)
- Low-Income Energy Assistance
 Program (LEAP) emergency financial help for those behind on electricity and natural gas bills
 - to apply call 519-883-2100
- AffordAbility support for energysaving upgrades for those who don't qualify for OESP or LEAP

Housing/Utilities?

- Region of Waterloo Help Paying Rent assistance for those at risk of losing home or experiencing homelessness

- Ontario Renovates loans for house upkeep or to install accessibility features
