**2018 Guideline Rent  
Increase 1.8 % Effective  
Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, 2018**

- ❖ All lease renewal rent increases has to follow the government increase guidelines
- ❖ The landlord must give you 90 days written notice before raising your rent.
- ❖ 2017 Interest paid on Last Month's Rent Deposit = 1.5%
- ❖ There's a new, required Standard Lease Form from Ontario's LTB, for all new rentals.
